Results: Hamilton Training Advisory Board Employer Survey – June 2010

The Hamilton Training Advisory Board thanks the employers who participated in our first monthly survey to provide information on their hiring increases and decreases during the past month.

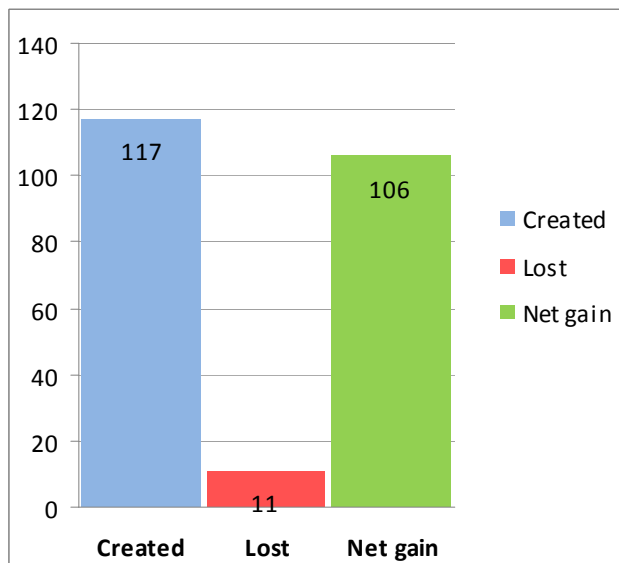
We hope that you will take part in the July employment survey which will be distributed on July 15 and will close on July 29. The results will be released on July 30th.

Highlights from the June 2010 survey

Twenty percent of employers who participated were from the Other Services (except Public Administration) sector; 12.5% were from Professional, Scientific/Technical services, and Retail Trade; 10% were from Construction, Manufacturing and Finance/Insurance.

Of the employers who participated, 77.5% indicated that their staffing levels remained the same, while the remaining 22.5% either increased or decreased staff. Six employers added staff, while three decreased their numbers.

Overall jobs gained/lost



The total number of positions added, both full and part-time, was 117, while the number of positions lost was 11, for a net gain of 106 jobs.

A sample of the types of occupations added or lost

Education
Jobs gained: various admin/teaching/cleaning

Construction
Jobs gained: labourers
Jobs lost: office workers

Manufacturing
Jobs gained: heavy manufacturing contingency workers
Jobs lost: technician, inventory clerks, IT, front office staff, welder

Professional/scientific/tech
Jobs gained: web, graphic design and admin

Healthcare/social assistance
Jobs gained: receptionist
Jobs lost: administrative

Retail
Jobs gained: cashiers, general labourers

Real estate/rental
Jobs gained: tenant liaison/secretary
